Resolved; to raise no objection to the application.

14/16 Bucks County Council Devolution Agreement. Bucks CC have offered Weedon Parish Council money, for a 3 year term, to take over the responsibility of cutting the grass verges within the village. After a short discussion the Parish Council
Resolved; to accept the offer and to sign the agreement.

15/16 Appointment of trustees to the Dr John Bridle's Charity. The Parish Council appoints two of the six trustees of the charity, each of whom serves for a 4 year term, but is then eligible for re-appointment. Mr Mike Moore has now reached the end of his 4-year term, but is happy to continue to serve as a trustee. After a short discussion the Parish Council
Resolved; to reappoint Mr Mike Moore as a trustee of the Dr John Bridle's Charity.

Appointment of trustees to the Lord Fortescue Charity. The Parish Council appoints four of the five trustees of the charity, each of whom serves for a 4 year term, but is then eligible for re-appointment. Rev Stephen Sidebotham and Mr Mike Moore have now reached the end of their 4-year term, but are happy to continue to serve as trustees. After a short discussion the Parish Council

Resolved; to reappoint Rev Stephen Sidebotham and Mr Mike Moore as trustees of the Lord Fortescue Charity
