Minutes of a Planning meeting of Weedon Parish Council held in The Methodist Chapel Weedon on Wednesday 23rd May 2018 at 8.45pm

Cllr T Jameson-Evans declared an interest in application 18/01520/APP as his property adjoins the application site. No other interests declared;

The applicant for 18/01484/APP explained the proposed plans and answered questions from the Council. The meeting re-opened

63/18 Planning.

18/01848/APP 11 High Street, Weedon, Buckinghamshire. Single story rear extension. Members **RESOLVED;** No Objection to planning application 18/01848/APP

The meeting closed to allow members of the public to give their views on application 18/01520/APP. All members of the public present agreed that although they had no objection to the cottage being extended they felt that the proposed design was out of character with the property and its setting.

The meeting reopened. Cllr T Jameson-Evans removed himself from the discussion.

18/01520/APP Valentine Cottage 9 Stockaway Weedon Buckinghamshire. Single story rear extension. After a short discussion the members **RESOLVED** to object to planning application 18/01520/APP. The members agreed that although they had no objection to the cottage being extended, they considered the proposed plan unacceptable. The proposed design does not respect the appearance and design of the dwelling and its setting and it would harm a well-used and attractive part of the village. Concern was also expressed that the plan appeared to show that the right hand dormer window in the RH elevation would be removed.
