## ***Dear Friends,***

At times it feels like we are being perpetually bombarded with advice about lifestyle, exercise and diet. This allows the opportunity for some to seek disciples for their very questionable advice whilst accruing income from those susceptible to their charms. For others of us, there is a state of confusion about what we should eat and how we should exercise. In particular, dieting is big business as companies compete to encourage us to adopt their way and, I suppose, add to their coffers.

In the midst of this often comes advice or encouragement about adopting a practice of fasting. This can range from complete abstinence as the Islamic commit to do during daylight hours in Ramadan, to setting aside particular foods - hence the traditional idea of eating fish on Fridays when the Christian community was encouraged to abstain from eating meat. Some churches make much of fasting. For Orthodox Christians, Lent is a time when you are encouraged to avoid eating meat while in this country Shrove Tuesday was the day to eat up all of the things from which you were meant to abstain during your Lenten fast.

I suppose it asks a question as to why fasting is thought to be important. In part the tradition stems from Jewish practice at the festival of Yom Kippur the holiest day in the Jewish calendar. This was a day of serious fasting, a day to adorn yourself with sackcloth and to sit in ashes as you prayed and sought God's forgiveness. A day of abstention. The problem was it that it became a day of show and ostentation - when being seen to be doing the right thing was really important and when often tempers became frayed as hungry people tended to clash. You can read the depiction of the way that the call to fast had been corrupted in Isaiah Chapter 58 in the Old Testament and hear the withering assault on those abusing the Jewish holiest day of the year.

So, in the midst of Lent, we have a chance to reflect what fasting should be like and what benefits it might bring. The original purpose was for people to reflect on their need of God and to amend their lives accordingly. In Isaiah 58 the encouragement is to fast in a way that brings liberation to those who are suffering from the impact of unjust acts of others. In essence, the season invites us to do something - not necessarily to abstain - but with an appropriate level of determination to try to make things better. This could relate to our relationship with God, or indeed our relationship with the world of which we are part. So, whether we contemplate what it is to be a more effective citizen, or dwell on the central truths of Christianity, both would be a good fast. As would things like considering our environment or what we can do to serve our local community, how we can enable something better and more productive to emerge.

Ash Wednesday, the traditional beginning point of Lent, has passed but there is still time to take the positive step of adopting something new and significant as we journey towards Easter, in the hope that the fast we have undertaken is not something that is set aside but becomes part of our ongoing reality. Lent invites change, encourages transformation. Surely, we could all find something that we could do in these days that would bring benefit - be it to ourselves, to the wider community, or worldwide.

While our fast could include abstaining from some foods as an act of discipline, a true fast should engender a positive flavour - a lasting, positive impact upon us and, hopefully, on the world.



# Wild Weedon

*The Weedon Wildlife Group  
aims to protect and promote  
wildlife in and around Weedon  
and Hardwick*



Have you noticed the birds are already sporting their breeding plumage and some are acting distinctly frisky?

The Woodpigeons have been strutting their stuff for a while but now the Robins and Blackbirds are joining in too. The Tawny owls are calling and will soon be sitting on eggs.

As the February flooding subsides and nature bounces back watch out for these and other signs of Spring such as Blackthorn in bloom, frogs' spawn in ponds and the first butterflies on the wing.

Milder weather will encourage moths and butterflies to come out early, but moths can struggle with the amount of light pollution about even in our villages. We can all help by fitting shielding to external lights to prevent light from escaping 'upwards' or spreading further than where it needs to be; using warmer bulb colours which are more beneficial to nocturnal insects; and introducing timers on non-essential lighting, for areas that do not need lighting throughout the entire night.

These simple measures can have a big impact – find out more about the marvellous world of moths here: <https://butterfly-conservation.org/moths-matter> Whatever you choose to do in your garden this spring remember to leave some wild patches to help our native insects thrive.




